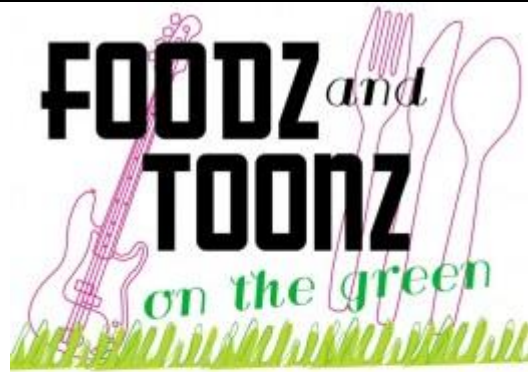

Infrastructure Report

Asbestos Roof Removal

ARC plans to remove all the asbestos from the rooves in the centre. This process is currently taking place and, as a result, 6 Huts have seen their rooves replaced with colour bond white zinc loom material and insulation. These are Huts 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and Hut 45. An Information meeting with the Safety Committee about the process and logistics of the asbestos removal was held with all the members affected by this work. All the buildings were previously sealed on the inside and the buildings were not accessible for the 2 day removal period but people were not required to remove their contents.

The result was a smooth operation that caused a minimal disruption for the Centre. Work Cover

monitored the whole process.

New Rainwater tank

We received a grant of \$18,683 from the NSW Department of Climate Change as part of the Public Facilities Program. A 25 kL rainwater tank has been installed to feed the main toilet block. Additionally, water saving dual flush toilets, urinals and spring-

loaded taps were fitted. The rainwater tank is fed by the Reverse Garbage and Sidetrack Theatre roof. It is anticipated that the rain water tank will supply all the water required to feed the main toilet block. This is in line with our endeavour for the Addison Road Centre to become water self sufficient within the next 10 years

Solar power era has started at ARC

We received a free Solar power installation for the ARC. Thanks to our local Sydney Energy Coop and its affiliate Greenforce Energy. Thomas Bywater from SEC generously offered us a free installation of about 2 kW of Solar Power which included all materials. The roof of the ARC office building was the most suitable location for the Solar Panels. An inverter needed to be installed behind the Art Gallery. The proposal included 22 * 90 W solar panels, the inverter, installation, all parts are included. According to Thomas Bywater the 2 kW system will supply us with 2920 kWh of solar energy per year which equates to an annual energy saving of about \$ 554.- .
